CLERK: (LR) 318, Madam President. Introduced by Senators Hartnett and Bruning, found on page 366 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Hartnett to open.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Madam Speaker, members of the body...or Madam Chairman, members of the body, I simply want to again this year recognize the Bellevue West Volleyball team. They've won their sixth consecutive volleyball title. Their record was 39 and 1. That is a continuous streak stretching over six years. I simply want to recognize the members of the team and the coach, Joanne Kappas. So with that, there's...would like to have the resolution approved.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Is there any discussion of LR 318? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett, do you wish to close? Closing is waived. The question before you is the adoption of LR 318. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.
