PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Pastor Jerry Heydenberk, from Faith United Methodist Church here in Lincoln. Pastor Heydenberk.

PASTOR HEYDENBERK: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Pastor Heydenberk. I now call the twelfth legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence. Please record.
