SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning our pastor is Ken Hoover from the Peace Lutheran Church of Waverly. Pastor, welcome.

PASTOR HOOVER: (Prayer offered.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Roll call. Would senators please record their presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Any messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Your committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 656 and (LB) 656A to Select File. Committee on Judiciary, chaired by Senator Brashear, reports (LB) 1069 and LR 310CA to General File; (LB) 1051, (LR) 303CA to General File with amendments; and LB 1021 indefinitely postponed. The Government Committee, chaired by Senator Robinson, reports LB 965, (LB) 1007 to General File; (LB) 951 to General File with amendments; and LB 905, (LB) 964, and (LB) 990 as indefinitely postponed. Those signed by Senator Robinson. Priority bill designations: (LB) 1041 has been selected by Senator Matzke as his priority bill. I have a series of appointment letters from the Governor, Mr. President. Those will be referred to Reference for referral to Standing Committee for confirmation hearing. And finally, a hearing notice from the Education Committee signed by Senator Bohlke as chair. Just an announcement, Mr. President, the Appropriations Committee will have an Executive Session today at 1:30. (See pages 427-31 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have.
