SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Will all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Will all unexcused members please report to the Chamber and record your presence. SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill is referred to the Judiciary Committee. Any items for the record?

CLERK: Yes, Mr. President, I do.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The call is raised.

CLERK: Your Committee on Business and Labor, chaired by Senator Abboud, reports LB 1010 to General File; (LB) 944 as indefinitely postponed; and (LB) 983 as indefinitely postponed. (See page 432 of the Legislative Journal.) That's all that I have, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We'll now move to General File, as it is approximately 10:00, and 1998 senator priority bills. LB 320. Mr. Clerk, would you give us the status.

CLERK: Mr. President, (LB) 320, on General File. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 14 of last year, at that time referred to Transportation. Advanced to General File. Committee amendments were attached. They were presented yesterday. Senator Bohlke opened on her bill. There was a Bohlke amendment adopted to the committee amendments.
