into this fund where they have a man working for more than one corporation. Limited liability companies, which, as you know, is kind of a cross between a partnership and a corporation, do not currently have this power. This is, I believe, an oversight and it is one that can be corrected by the insertion of just those four words, and those four words are "or limited liability companies". It merely adds them to the list of people who can do this. If there is any questions, I will be happy to answer them, but it's a very simple bill and I won't take a lot of the Chamber's time. I just ask that it be moved forward to Select.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the opening, those wishing to debate LB 834...yes, 834, thank you. Seeing none, Senator Tyson, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR TYSON: Waive that, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Closing has been waived. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 834 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 834.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 834 is advanced to E & R Initial. Next item is LB 360, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 360, Mr. President, introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 15, referred to the Government Committee, advanced to General File. I have no committee amendments. I do have one other amendment, however, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on LB 360.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, thank you. LB 360 is, very simply stated, designed to prevent the inappropriate use by any public official subject to the Accountability and Disclosure Act of utilizing resources available to them by reason of their public service for
