SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of calling the house vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 18 ayes, 2 nays to place the house under call.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The house is under call. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Would all unexcused members please report to the Chamber and record their presence. The house is under call. Senator Abboud, Senator Raikes, Schellpeper, and Schrock. Senator Schrock, would you please record your presence. Senator Schmitt, the house is under call. Senator Witek, would you please record your presence. All members are present. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 471 of the Legislative Journal.) 1 aye, 32 nays on the motion to reconsider.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion to reconsider fails. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports (LB) 320, (LB) 497, (LB) 834, (LB) 369 to Select File. Urban Affairs reports (LB) 319, (LB) 481, (LB) 487, (LB) 637, (LB) 651, (LB) 763, (LB) 825, (LB) 826, (LB) 836, (LB) 991 as indefinitely postponed. Amendments to be printed to (LB) 939 by Senator Chambers and Senator Lynch. Rereferencing of LB 1337, that's offered by the Reference Committee. A series of adds: Senator Lynch, to add his name to (LB) 1183; Senator Thompson, to (LB) 536 and (LB) 301; Senator Hartnett to (LB) 822; Senator Wehrbein to withdraw his name from (LB) 1285.
