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phone calls, calls, calling about that ballot issue? So then I'm using the phone call to return that phone call to someone that I don't know what they're calling me about, whether it's about that ballot issue or not. So I recognize and Senator Brashear says, no, this is aimed at blatant behavior, individuals who would send out a newsletter during an election, and then at the very bottom put, paid for by your election, but make it look very similar to something that would come out of your office, those kinds of questionable letters that go out to political parties thanking them for this or that en masse, that they go out to all members, those kinds of areas where we're not sure. But I have to tell you quite honestly, I will vote for the Matzke amendment. I don't know if I am going to vote for this bill, because there are too many areas where I think someone politically could come after you and make you go to court. And I don't, personally, have the resources to go ahead and fight that, I don't have them in my campaign accounts, I run what they call grassroots campaigns, I'm not a lawyer, I can't go represent myself in court. And to have to go hire someone to represent me in what is probably a frivolous lawsuit against me, but based on this language that is not clear and that is very broadly written, I would have to go to court to defend myself. That makes me uncomfortable and that makes me concerned that what we really need in this Legislature is an ethics committee. We really need our Executive Board to be an ethics committee for us. There are a lot of ethical questions in this body, and we don't have anybody to go to or to point to, to say, this...this behavior on another senator's part makes me uncomfortable, I think it's a question of ethics, and I would like you to rule on whether this should be done, or whether we can continue to do this, or whether this is beyond the line that I have drawn for myself.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR WITEK: My line may be farther back than other senators' line on what behavior they draw for themselves. So while we really need an ethics committee in the Legislature, I think if we pass this I think we're going in the wrong direction by saying this is the legal behavior and it should be interpreted by Accountability and Disclosure. I would be much more comfortable having our Executive Committee or another committee
