SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BRUNING: Mr. Speaker, I move the E & R amendments to LB 901.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. All those opposed say nay. The E & R amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bruning, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR BRUNING: Mr. Speaker, I move LB 901 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. All those in favor of advancing LB 901 say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. LB 902, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 902, Senator, no amendments to the bill.
