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involved ourselves in divorce issues, because we've involved ourselves in child custody issues, because we've involved ourselves in child support issues, this is something that we should be involved in, and I believe that the court should have power over those individuals. All that said, I am less than comfortable, as one of the cosponsors of this legislation and a big supporter of it, with moving forward with the rule suspension. I have been listening closely to the debate, I've been listening closely to what Senator Jensen has said, and I really think that we could have spent a little bit more time on it. The bend Senator Chambers puts us in a corner where if we just are following our belief that maybe a little bit more time should be allowed, he threatens us about what's going to happen and so it makes me not even sure that I want to oppose the rule suspension because I'm not doing it based on anything that has been said about what's going to happen for the rest of the session. I'm doing it because of what I believe, and I think I should make that decision every single time, I think I should have the right to make that decision every single time, I think I should have the right to debate as long as I see fit on a bill, even if I'm a cosponsor, and I should have the right to suspend the rules if I see fit without every single time feeling like it's going to be the wrath of one individual that's going to come down. This...to me the decision is not going to be based on how Senator Jensen feels or how Senator Chambers feels, but on whether we've had enough time to talk about this. I, obviously, had made some decisions prior to coming to this floor because I signed onto the bill. But I always, always listen to the debate that goes on and make sure that my decisions have been consistent with what I continue to hear. I am perfectly comfortable with what we've adopted so far, but I think we could have continued to have a little bit more discussion. I don't think I will support the rule suspension at this point in time. But I want it very clear that my decision is based on my own sense of whether we've had enough time on this and not anything that Senator Chambers may say about what's going to happen in the rest of the session. Thank you.
