SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...on General File.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Before we move to the next item, Senator Bohlke has the following guest visiting the Legislature, Loren Laun from Hastings. He's seated under the north balcony. Please rise and be recognized by your Legislature. Welcome. Mr. Clerk, we have an item.

CLERK: Mr. President, I do have a couple of items and an amendment, if I may. Banking Committee reports (LB) 1194 to General File with amendments. Hearing notice from Retirement Systems, and gubernatorial appointment letters to the Power Review Board and then Crime Victims Reparation Committee. (See pages 612-15 of the Legislative Journal.)

Senator Chambers would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (See FA490 on page 615 of the Legislative Journal.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, and to those who support this bill, if you want time to review this before you consent to it, it will not bother me at all. But there are three places in the bill where my amendment would apply. For the record, at page 33, lines 23 and 24, at page 41, line 2, at page 42, line 25, I would strike the words "or voluntary manslaughter". And here is the language that I'm dealing with, not where a person is convicted of voluntary manslaughter, but this aided, abetted, attempted, conspired, or solicited is what I would strike. And since in that listing you also have murder, I'm not just striking that entire provision, I would leave in place aided or abetted, attempted, conspired, or solicited to commit murder of the juvenile or another child of the parent, all that stays in.
