As Senator Chambers might remember, what happens is that the State Claims Board reviews these claims and they have 60 steps...60 days to...for reviewing purposes, for appeal purposes. So the committee does not receive these bills until about a week ago, at the end of last month, January. So that's why we always get them a little late, and we always enjoy the hearings together, and Senator Chambers will certainly be there to inform the body of what the testimony was on these claims bills since he serves on the committee. The hearing will be on March 2nd, if anyone is interested in attending, and we also have information as far as on each one of the individualized claims that are coming before the committee if you request that information prior to the hearing. With that, I would urge the adoption and movement of the motion.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Abboud. The motion is to suspend the rules. It requires 30 affirmative votes. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote no. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the introduction of the new bills.

SENATOR LANDIS: Before the Chair calls on Senator Kristensen to make a motion to recess, are there any things that the Clerk would like to read into the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, there are. Thank you. New bills. (Read LB 1362 and LB 1363 by title for the first time.) In addition to those items, Mr. President, your Committee on Revenue reports (LB) 1174 to General File with amendments; Transportation reports (LB) 909 and (LB) 1264 to General File, (LB) 1187, (LB) 1207 General File with amendments. Banking Committee reports (LB) 1162 to General File, (LB) 1201 General File, (LB) 1245 and (LB) 1282, all to General File. I have motions, Senator Beutler, to be printed to LB 1041, Senator Will to (LB) 309, Senator Brashear to (LB) 1128, and, finally, Mr. President, adds. Senator Jensen would like to add his name to (LB) 204, Senator Maurstad (LB) 1041. An announcement, Natural Resources will be meeting in Room 1517 at one-thirty.
