SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: The first division would be all of line 1 where we say "strike original Section 3 and all amendments thereto." Then as a part of that division, we drop down to line number 9 and there's a semicolon after the word "thereto." We take the language following that semicolon, which would be "and strike lines 13 through 19" and we would add that part alone to the first line.

SENATOR COORDSEN: That is correct.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. I now understand it.

SENATOR COORDSEN: That's not quite correct? I don't have a copy. The Clerk has a copy of it. Would you state why...

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Chambers, your...

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...I was in error, please?

ASSISTANT CLERK: ...characterization is right except that Section 6, which is also line 11, becomes a part of the same division that line 1 does. So...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Go ahead.

ASSISTANT CLERK: So it starts at the semicolon in line 9 through the balance of the entire amendment,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

ASSISTANT CLERK: ...which includes "renumber the remaining sections."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Thank you. I got it.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Maurstad, on the first part of the division. (First part of the division is assigned FA527, which appears on page 813 of the Legislative Journal.)
