PRESIDENT ROBAK PRESIDING

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Our chaplain for the day is Chaplain Harland Johnson.

CHAPLAIN JOHNSON: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Chaplain Johnson. I now call the forty-second legislative day to order. Will senators please record your presence. Please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any corrections to the Journal?

CLERK: (Read correction as found on page 1005 of the Legislative Journal.) That's the correction this morning.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Any messages, reports, and announcements?

CLERK: Madam President, Select File, Committee on Enrollment and Review reports LB 1333 and (LB) 1333A to Select File. Education Committee reports LB 1176 to General File. I have an explanation of vote from Senator Wehrbein (re LB 939). A new resolution by Senator Kristensen congratulating the Kearney High School wrestling team (LR 331). That's all that I have, Madam President. (See pages 1005-07 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We then turn to special order General File, 1998 appropriations bill and LB 1108.

CLERK: LB 1108, introduced by the Speaker at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 12, Madam President, referred to the Appropriations Committee, advanced to General File. There are committee amendments pending.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chair recognizes Senator Kristensen to open on the bill.
