CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. The amendment is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We're now debating the advancement of LB 1108. Senator Vrtiska...Senator Wehrbein, excuse me, you are recognized to close on the advancement of LB 1108.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you very much, Mr. Speaker, members. We've had a discussion. I know there's going to be more questions over the next few days as we come to Select File, free to ask. Don't ever lose track of your little, blue book, all of the answers are in there, just needs to be interpreted. With that, I move the advancement.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1108 to E & R Initial. All those in favor of advancement vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 1108.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill is advanced. Next bill, LB 1110. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (LB) 1110, by Senator Hartnett. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, referred to Appropriations, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to open on your bill.
