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when it's absolutely necessary. I don't think we are at that point yet. With that, I would yield the rest of my time to Senator Chambers.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you have approximately three minutes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Will. Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Beutler a question. Senator Beutler,...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler, would you respond?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...where are these other bills that you had referenced, in the process where are they located?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Starting at the top, Senator, 695 is before you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: (LB) 1136...you'd have to ask Senator Wickersham. I don't know where the bill itself is.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Right, but at least it's being discussed now.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But, of course, the amendment is before you right now...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...with a reduced fiscal note. LB 512 is on Final Reading; and LB 507 is on General File.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Senator Beutler, do you think that if something were to be done, as substantial as what you're discussing now, that it would be appropriate to amend a bill on Final Reading to do that?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, Senator, I think it depends on what discussion and what familiarity the body has had with the matters before that point in time. It's not the preferred
