have to distribute anything. So I think it's all been worked out and I hope it meets with your approval. The private schools are not included. I did contact the private schools to see if they would have objection to being included. They did have objection. But they didn't want to be legally required to do so, so they were left out of the amendment. Applies only to public schools and to hospitals. Thank you.
