SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, I support the Brown amendment also and I'm just really glad that damn sunset's not attached now. (Laughter)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Jensen.

SENATOR JENSEN: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I just want to stand up and say that I was very pleased to be a cosponsor of this bill. We are a mobile society and we have children moving in and out of communities and many times the parents themselves forget or don't know if a child was immunized and so now when they seek healthcare they're going to be able to pull these records up immediately and, therefore, treat the child appropriately. So I'd just ask the body to certainly endorse this amendment. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Brown, you're recognized to close on your amendment. She waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Brown amendment to LB 1063. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Brown's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Maurstad would move to amend with AM3829.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Maurstad, you're recognized to open with your amendment.

SENATOR MAURSTAD: Like to ask to withdraw that amendment, please.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
