CLERK: 36 ayes, 3 nays, on the adoption of Senator Wesely's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Wesely amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Madam President. A reference report referring certain gubernatorial appointees for a confirmation hearing; Senator Thompson, amendments to (LB) 1073 to be printed; Education reports (LB) 1175 to General File with committee amendments attached. PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next amendment, and I raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Hillman would move to amend, 3878. (See AM3878 on pages 1143-44 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Hillman, to open on her amendment.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Yes, thank you, Madam...excuse me, Madam Chairman and members. This is an Appropriations Committee amendment, and Senator Wehrbein wasn't here at the time we needed to introduce it, and so I was asked to do that. But I would now ask to...Senator Wehrbein, if you would like to explain this amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Wehrbein.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I don't know whether I'd like...Madam Speaker and members, I don't know whether I'd like to do it or not. I could defer to Senator Hillman, but I will do that. These are some technical amendments, by and large. I'll explain to you if they are a little more than that. And I guess I'll start down the list as I have it. One of them is the corrective amendment to the Attorney General's Office.
