SENATOR WILL: LB 632 is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. New resolutions, (LR) 343 by Senator Landis and Wesely congratulating Northeast High School basketball team. (LR) 344, study resolution by Senator Suttle. Senator Landis amendments to (LB) 1073; Senator Schimek to (LB) 1162; Senator Wickersham to (LB) 1104. (See pages 1194-97 of the Legislative Journal.)

Mr. President, the next bill, LB 699, a bill by...

SENATOR WILL: We will temporarily pass over LB 699 and move to LB 1126.

CLERK: Mr. President, 1126 by Senator Engel...or Elmer, excuse me, Senator Elmer. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 13, referred to Natural Resources, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill.

SENATOR WILL: Senator Elmer, you're recognized to open on...we'll temporarily stand at ease.

SENATOR WILL: I see that Senator Elmer is present. Senator Elmer, you are recognized to open on LB 1126.

SENATOR ELMER: Thank you, Senator Will. LB 1126 is an annual bill that comes before us that's necessary for us to pass to allow the Community Improvement Funds that are provided by the low-level radioactive waste compact to the Boyd County communities to continue for another year. This is an annual update and is an exercise that we must do, I feel, to continue to provide the people with the resources that they need to monitor and advance the...cause in the low-level waste issue.
