SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Senator Hillman. We will now be voting on the Hillman amendment to LB...3931 to LB 924. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay.

SENATOR HILLMAN: Mr. Chairman, I think we're going to need a call of the house and I'll accept call-in votes.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All those in favor of the call of the house vote aye; those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 16 ayes, 0 nays, to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The house is under call. All those not excused, please report to the chamber. Call-in votes have been asked for, so...Abboud, Beutler. Senator Stuhr and Senator Bromm, please report to the chamber. Senator Dwite Pedersen and Senator Chris Peterson. Senator Robak and Senator Schellpeper, please report to the chamber. Senator Bromm, Senator Tyson. Senator Vrtiska, Senator Hudkins, the house is under call. Senator Beutler, the house is under call. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Brashear. Senator Schrock, please report to the chamber. The house is under call. I remind you we are accepting call-in votes also. Senator Schrock, please report to the chamber. The house is under call. Mr. Clerk, is everyone accounted for?

CLERK: As soon as Senator Schrock checks in, they are.

SENATOR HILLMAN: I request a roll call vote.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Senator Hillman has requested a roll call vote. We are voting on the Hillman Amendment 3991, to LB 924. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See pages 1239-40 of the Legislative Journal.) 30 ayes, 0 nays, on adoption of the amendment.

SENATOR JANSSEN: The amendment is adopted, Mr. Clerk. I'll raise the call. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.
