There are 50 fourth grade students here from Crete Elementary School in Crete, Nebraska, and their teachers. (Introduced teachers.) They are all seated in the south balcony. Will you all stand to be recognized, please. Welcome to the Nebraska Legislature. And Senator Robinson announces that the following guests are also visiting the Legislature today. Dr. Paul Kennedy from Omaha, Jerry Fardal and Wes Rieke are all here from Omaha seated under the north balcony. Gentlemen, will you stand to be recognized, please. Welcome to the Legislature. Senator Kristensen, Senator Bohlke, will you check in, please. Senator Schellpeper, Senator Coordsen, will you check in, please. Senator Brashear, Senator Engel, Senator Bromm, Senator Landis, Senator Robinson, Senator Witek, Senator Kiel, Beutler and Wesely and Hillman. While the Legislature's in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign Legislative Bill 1173, LB 204A and LB 204. (See page 1559 of the Legislative Journal.) Senator Kristensen, Senator Schellpeper, Senator Brashear, Senator Bromm. Senator Landis, will you check in, please. Senator Robinson, Senator Kiel. Senator Kristensen, Senator Schellpeper, and Senator Bromm. Senator Engel. We're waiting for Senator Schellpeper. Senator Engel, you requested a roll call vote in reverse order, is that correct? We are waiting for Senator Schellpeper. Senator Chambers, Senator Schellpeper is unavailable. Would you like to proceed?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: What's he doing, cleaning his pistols, or he's not on the scene? Okay, I'll take a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LB 59. Senator Engel requested a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken. See page 1560 of the Legislative Journal.) 4 ayes, 26 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Chambers amendment fails. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.
