SENATOR HILGERT: On page 5 of the green copy, which is not affected by the committee amendments, it says, "The city council, village board, county board or tribal government shall not act affirmatively with regard to any matter requiring the approval of the enterprise zone association board until such time as it has received the approval of the enterprise zone association board as provided." I assume that there's certainly another argument, another side of the coin, if you will, but to make the city council basically subrogated to a volunteer, appointed board is an interesting policy move. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I think it's simply just so that there's better communication, Senator Hilgert; that's really the purpose of it. If there's no other lights, I'd ask for the advancement of the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: There are no further lights. Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Just move for the advancement.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the advancement of LB 1259 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Please record.
