CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: We're now debating advancement to E & R Initial. Senator Wesely, you're recognized to close on advancement.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, for your patience and everybody else's patience. We have a bill that's in good shape and will deal with some important topics. I'd ask your support for advancement.
