LB 1104, 1266, 1293A

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on adoption of Senator Hartnett's amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Hartnett amendment is adopted. Is there any discussion on the advancement of LB 1293A? Seeing none, Senator Hartnett, to close.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Waive.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Closing is waived. The question before you is the advancement of LB 1293A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on the advancement of 1293A.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: LB 1293A advances. LB 1266.

CLERK: Madam President, some items if I may.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Items for the record.

CLERK: Senator Wickersham, amendments to (LB) 1104 to be printed. (See pages 1742-44 of the Legislative Journal.)

Legislative Bill 1266, a bill originally introduced by Senator Wesely. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 21 of this year, at that time referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Madam President.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Chair recognizes Senator Wesely to open on the bill.

SENATOR WESELY: Thank you, Madam President, members. LB 1266 is a bill introduced by Senator Hilgert and myself but in actuality it's a bill introduced by Senator Chambers that we picked up the gauntlet and are trying to help out along the way here. Senator Chambers has picked it as his priority bill and allowed us to bring this to your attention. For those of you, and I think almost all of us were here last year but for a couple of members, we adopted last year, wow, almost exactly a year ago, on the 10th of April, on a vote of 26 to 5, an
