is with respect to a contract with a public power district, it's your intention that the public power district would continue to be required to follow the laws relating to bidding for contracts entered into by public power districts. They don't have a choice of law, but they have to continue to comply with that law. Is that accurate?

SENATOR MATZKE: Yes, that's absolutely correct.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, thank you very much. Thank you, Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. Just a brief comment, I appreciate the work that Senator Bromm and particularly Senator Brown put into dealing with the issue of elevators in churches. If anyone here does know of any church that's having difficulty getting an elevator put in, please let me know because we do have some contractors who are willing to work with them, get them elevators that would meet their needs and requirements and have done a real good job in making it cost effective and affordable for those churches which I think we're all concerned about. So if any of the parishes, any of the churches in your district have those problems, over the summer and interim we would certainly be willing to make some contacts with those people and get that addressed. Thank you.
