SENATOR BEUTLER: And I want to make clear again that the intent is to gut LB 512, take everything out of it and replace it with the Beutler amendment which I think this is what is before you. Thank you.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 512. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Please have everybody check in and a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Thank you, Senator. Senators, we are on Final Reading if you would please check in. Senator Beutler, will you check in. Senator Cudaback and Senator Hartnett. Excuse me, Senator Hartnett is excused. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment to LB 512. Senator Beutler requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please proceed.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken.) (See pages 1879-80 of the Legislative Journal.) 22 ayes, 14 nays on the amendment.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: The Beutler amendment fails. LB 512 returns to Final Reading. Excuse me. The bill is on Select File. Senator Bruning.

SENATOR BRUNING: Madam President, I move LB 512 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, members of the Legislature, this should stay right where it is because there's nothing to it. And to make sure that no mischief would occur in any way, we should just vote no or don't vote at all and let it languish on Select File.

PRESIDENT ROBAK: Senator Beutler. Do you wish to speak on the advancement of LB 512?

SENATOR BEUTLER: No.
