A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to dead animals; to amend section 54-725,
2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 28-101,
3 Revised Statutes Supplement, 1998; to transfer a section
4 to the Nebraska Criminal Code; and to repeal the original
5 sections.
6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-101, Revised Statutes Supplement,
2 1998, is amended to read:

3 28-101. Sections 28-101 to 28-1348 and section 2 of this
4 act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Criminal Code.

5 Sec. 2. Section 54-725, Reissue Revised Statutes of
6 Nebraska, is amended to read:

7 ~~54-725.~~ The liquified remains of any dead animal may be
8 injected below the surface of the ground but may not be spread
9 above the surface of the ground in any manner. Any person
10 violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a Class
11 II misdemeanor.

13 Statutes of Nebraska, and section 28-101, Revised Statutes
14 Supplement, 1998, are repealed.
