A BILL

1 FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend section
2 28-1249, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change
3 provisions relating to the sale of fireworks; and to
4 repeal the original section.

5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-1249, Reissue Revised Statutes of
2 Nebraska, is amended to read:

3 28-1249. (1) It shall be unlawful to sell any
4 permissible fireworks at retail within this state, outside the
5 limits of any incorporated city or village.

6 (2) ~~Permissible~~ Except as provided in subsection (3) of
7 this section, permissible fireworks may be sold at retail only
8 between June 24 and July 5 of each year.

9 (3)(a) For the celebration of the year 2000, permissible
10 fireworks may be sold at retail also between December 28, 1999, and
11 January 1, 2000.

12 (b) All sales tax collected from the sale of fireworks
13 pursuant to this subsection shall be remitted to the State
14 Treasurer for credit to the Fire Insurance Tax Fund.
