PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Jones, 43; Schmitt, 41

Read first time January 6, 2000

1 Rereferred to Government, Military & Veterans Affairs

2 THE MEMBERS OF THE NINETY-SIXTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA,
3 SECOND SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

4 Section 1. At the general election in November 2000 the
5 following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall
6 be submitted to the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval
7 or rejection:

8 To amend Article III, section 6:

9 III-6 "The Legislature shall consist of not more than
10 ~~fifty~~ fifty-five members and not less than thirty members. The
11 sessions of the Legislature shall be annual except as otherwise
12 provided by this constitution or as may be otherwise provided by
13 law."

14 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the
15 electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska,
16 Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

17 "A constitutional amendment to change the maximum number
18 of members of the Legislature.
