## LEGISLATIVE BILL 119

Approved by the Governor May 25, 1999

Introduced by Crosby, 29

AN ACT relating to public health and welfare; to amend section 68-1006.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1998; to change provisions relating to personal needs allowance for certain assistance recipients; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 68-1006.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1998, is amended to read:

68-1006.01. The Department of Health and Human Services shall include in the standard of need for eligible aged, blind, and disabled persons at least forty fifty dollars per month for a personal needs allowance if such persons reside in an alternative living arrangement.

For purposes of this section, an alternative living arrangement shall include board and room, a licensed boarding home, a certified adult family home, a licensed assisted-living facility, a licensed group home for children or child-caring agency, a licensed center for the developmentally disabled, and a long-term care facility.

Sec. 2. Original section 68-1006.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1998, is repealed.
