PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Is there any discussion? Hearing none, Senator Brashear, you are recognized to close on LB 43. Senator Brashear waives closing. The motion before us is to advance LB 43 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 43.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: LB 43 is advanced to E & R Initial. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 44, by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 7, referred to Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. I have no amendments to the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Chair recognizes Senator Brashear to open on LB 44.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, members of the body, Legislative Bill 44 inserts unintentionally omitted language in the statutes. In Neb. Rev. Stat. 28-201 we define the crime of criminal attempt. The penalty section of the statute defines the penalty for all grades of offenses, except where the attempted crime is a Class IC, or Class ID felony. LB 44 corrects that omission. I'd urge the advancement of the bill. Thank you.
