PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: (Recorder not activated immediately.) ...George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifteenth day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, First Session. Our prayer of the day will be provided this morning by the Legislature's chaplain, Harland Johnson.
