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particular amendment because the statute sections that we're dealing with, with motor vehicles is found in Chapter 60, I believe the mobile home section is in 69. It's called "mobile home", yes, but it is not a motorized vehicle. I would request a ruling from the Chair.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you. Senator Suttle, would you care to respond to the challenge?

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you. If you will...if you will look at the amendment, you will see that we are amending Section 60 and not Section 69. We are amending the title and abandonment laws, not dealing with mobile homes, per se; we're dealing with title. And the amendment is changing it to 60 and 69.

SENATOR COORDSEN: All right, okay.

SENATOR SUTTLE: I think I'm finished. I'm finished. It's up to you now, sir.

SENATOR COORDSEN: All right, thank you. We'll be back to you in a moment. Okay, members of the body, Senator Suttle, after examination of your amendment, it appears to me that all of the substantive changes go to Chapter 69 of our statutes, and the committee amendments reference only Chapter 60. Therefore, I'm going to rule that your amendment is not germane. Okay. The next amendment is by Senator Chambers to the committee amendments. Senator Chambers, to open on your amendment. (See FAS on page 418 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I want you all to overlook the gentleman who is in prayer and meditation to my immediate right, but it shows how tolerant, broad-minded, and understanding that I am. What this amendment does is to put in two places in the bill the following language, then I will explain it, "or valid in-transit decals issued pursuant to Section 60-320". We are saying in the bill, as it would stand with the committee amendments, that if this vehicle does not have current license plates, this would simply add "or a valid", we call them "in-transit" stickers. That's all that is being added to the bill. If you have any questions, I will answer them. But this again is one of those situations
