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SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on your amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the Legislature and Senator Schimek, I would rather work that amendment out, as we may look at other aspects of the bill. At this...excuse me. At this point, I wanted a minimum bit of activity undertaken so the bill would not move forward without any reference to the nature of these buildings, other than just leaving the word "buildings" in the bill. So I am not unwilling to work through that other suggestion. And that's all that I have by way of a close. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to the committee amendments. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body, the only thing that I have to say is that now the bill reads that these telephone conferences will be held in public buildings. That's the way the amendment reads and I ask you to adopt the amendment.
