SENATOR LYNCH: (AM)491.

CLERK: (AM)491, your amendment 491. (AM0491 is found on page 706 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator, you're recognized to open on your amendment, 491.

SENATOR LYNCH: Yeah, Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members, this amendment simply clarified in the Tyson amendment what is meant by a "organization of nonunion employees", and then in 9 and also in 12 it took out "organization" because I wasn't quite sure and I didn't think anybody else was sure of what he meant by that. But I don't really care what he meant by that at this point, so I would respectfully ask that this amendment be withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator, I...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator, let's clarify what amendment we are recognizing you...

SENATOR LYNCH: Okay. No, we have another one.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: ...for so that we don't get out of order. So I'll ask the Clerk to, once again, visit with you.

CLERK: Senator, I was...I'm sorry, I'm on Amendment 491, which is an amendment to the bill, and I think the amendment you just described was one you had drafted to the amendment...

SENATOR LYNCH: Oh, okay.

CLERK: ...that Senator Tyson had. So we are on...what I have on the desk is AM0491.

SENATOR LYNCH: Right. Mister...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator, would you like to take up...

SENATOR LYNCH: Yes, Mr. Speaker and members, I...this amendment is an amendment to the bill, I guess, not to Tyson's...Senator
