PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. The question before us is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to LB 578. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The Chambers amendment is agreed to. Further discussion on the advancement of LB 578? Senator Janssen, you're recognized to close on LB 578.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. Members of the Legislature, good discussion on this bill again. I think we got some things ironed out. It's always good to see Senator Chambers and Senator Beutler agreeing to find better way...ways to make the bill much better. Thank you, to you two gentlemen. With that, I just hope you will find it favorable to pass LB 578 onto Select File. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you for your closing, Senator Janssen. The motion before us is the advancement of LB 578 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of 578.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.
