PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. Further discussion on the advancement of LB 574. Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close. Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before us is the advancement of LB 574 to E & R Initial. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 574.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Your Committee on Education reports (LB) 182 to General File with amendments, (LB) 646 indefinitely postponed, (LB) 726 indefinitely postponed. Hearing notice from Retirement Systems. Senator Wickersham, an amendment to (LB) 141. Reference report referring the claims bills and a hearing notice from Business and Labor for scheduling of those two bills, Mr. President. That's all that I have. PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Pursuant to today's agenda, LB 149.

CLERK: Mr. President, 149 on Select File. Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all, Senator.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 149.
