SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Senator, Senator, they're not using false IDs. They're using their actual IDs and they're still selling it to them. That's our...our problem. I don't think we should tell them to use false IDs.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But you're setting up a mechanism by which if they choose to use a false ID they can avoid the law, if they are choosing to use a false ID.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: They're not doing it. They're using their actual ID currently. They're going in. They can be 18 years old currently. They give them this ID, and they still sell them the alcohol. They're not...not one of them are using false IDs.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, I mean, that's a problem too.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: What? What's the problem?

SENATOR BEUTLER: The problem you just described.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Well, but, if they're going in with this here sting and they're 18 years old, they show it to the retailer and the retailer looks at it and he still sells them the alcohol, then he's...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Even though it shows they're underage.

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: Right.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah. Well, there are different ways of setting up a sting or doing it, I suppose,...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: But...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...but...

SENATOR SCHELLPEPER: ...but what you're saying, if you don't want the truthful identification, then you want false IDs, and I don't think you want that.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Isn't part of the problem in certain situations the fact that people give false IDs?
