SENATOR COORDSEN PRESIDING

SENATOR COORDSEN: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber, the forty-fifth legislative day. Our chaplain for this day, Monday, March 15, is Chaplain Rich Carlson, who is the chaplain of Union College in, I believe, Senator Crosby's district. Chaplain.

Health and Human Services reports (LB) 480 to General File; (LB) 548, General File with amendments; LB 800, General File with amendments. That's all that I had, Mr. President. SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Moving on to General File, senator priority bills, Mr. Clerk.
