shotgun in the snow? He said, yes, Grandpa, I know what would happen. He said, that would clog the barrel,...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...and then you...I would have to take the...the shells out of the chamber and clean that snow from the barrel, because, if I didn't, he said, that shotgun, even though I am in control of it, could harm me very severely, if I would fire it when the barrel was obstructed by the snow. So these are the kind of things...young people take this course at the age of about, I think it's 11 or 12. And I could see just by the hours that he had taken on how to handle the shotgun, how to fire it and so on that he was well instructed. And, yes, I would hope everyone, everyone would be able to take some type of a safety training course, because I think that is so important, and it's an important part of this piece of legislation, and I am comfortable with that.
