ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1677-1678.) The vote is 40 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 640 with the emergency clause attached passes. LB 681.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 681 on final reading.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 681 pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1678.) The vote is 41 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, 6 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 681 passes. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 581, LB 618, LB 621, LB 621A, LB 640 with the emergency clause, and LB 681. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. The bills that were read on Final Reading this morning were presented to the Governor. (LB 297, LB 432, LB 552, LB 68, LB 68A, LB 101, LB 194, LB 324, LB 475, LB 574, LB 141, LB 99, LB 469, LB 608, LB 674, LB 674A, and LB 43.) Amendments to be printed to LB 496 from Senator Kristensen, LB 271 from Senator Coordsen, LB 530 from Senator Matzke, to LB 594 by Senator Dierks, LB 585 by Senator Bromm, LB 630 by Senator Wehrbein, LB 550 by Senator Landis. New study resolution LR 74 introduced by the Urban Affairs Committee. (Legislative Journal pages 1679-1682.) And that's all I have, Mr. President.
