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listening to Senator Jensen, he mentioned in his testimony here that there was...hadn't been really any plans were made for as far as how to implement this work camp. And I know this was started in the 1980...late 1988. And I know, I think it was the third time we tried to get the bill through was when we got it through, two years ago. So there has been a lot of planning as far as ...as far as how they wanted this to operate. And then I was talking to Senator Redfield here, too, as far as the location of it, you know, and where it is McCook. I know that's a bone of contention. But, as far as what type of work will they do out there, well, the plans they have...the first...it's going to be an incremental plan. In the first month they'll be working on maintenance, et cetera, et cetera, within the facility. So that keeps them plenty busy in there. Then they're already communicating with the Games and Parks and the community of McCook and so forth as far as having them work outside the facility in, you know, on the street department and maintenance and the Games and Parks and so forth. So they've got it fairly well set up as far as where they can keep these hundred people, that are in there at any one time, busy. So they will be learning work ethics, along with their rehabilitation as far as to drugs, alcohol, education, et cetera. So they do have a plan. And then in the last month that they're in there they will be talking to Job Services in their communities where they reside, as far as lining them up with a job. So there will be plenty of work for them to do, even though it's not next to an existing facility. So I just wanted to offer that for your information.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Engel. Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close on the motion to bracket LB 880.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, while we were not discussing the bracket motion but having discussions on that motion, I've drafted some more, because I've been forced to read this budget bill. And I see some things that kind of disturb me, and I've only gotten to page 2. For example, on page 2, it talks about encumbered amounts...okay, here's what it says, starting in line 1 on page 2, "All General Fund appropriations existing on June 30, 1999, in excess of expended and encumbered amounts are hereby lapsed unless
