PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Question before us is the motion to reconsider the vote on Floor Amendment 133. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 1 aye, 7 nays on the motion to reconsider, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Motion to reconsider is not agreed to. Mr. Clerk, any items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President, thank you. I have...Senator Bromm has an amendment to LB 571 to be printed, and I have a new resolution, LR 80, by Senator Connealy. (Read brief description.) That will be laid over. That's all that I had, Mr. President. Thank you. (See page 1759 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. Senator, I have your amendment that starts on page 1, line 20; page 2, line 4. It's what I'm calling Floor Amendment 147. (FA147 is found on page 1759 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, thank you, Mr. President, I mean Mr. Clerk.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers.
