SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...or outside of...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: No.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...Douglas County?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's Lancaster, Adams, Douglas, Lancaster, Lincoln, Dakota, Sherman, Omaha, Thurston County on the Winnebago Indian Reservation, Cheyenne County, Dawson County, Sarpy County, Washington County.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Those are the only counties that are working on them so far?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Those are the ones in process.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. There might be some poetic justice here after all. Maybe the...my rural colleagues are being shown something that I was telling you about yesterday. See, Omaha and Douglas County have a large enough population base and ways to get grants and do things here and there that the littler counties and cities don't have, so they got all of you rural people to run in here and vote for their convention center, and then when you have your little programs out there, your "piddly" little programs, your little pinhead people who you call your leaders trying to get something done to get a few nickels, then what happens to your leaders in Omaha, those you made you all sit over there in that lounge and sleep with them when they were getting their convention center, and then you need something today and what do they tell you? No. Well, why should they give you anything? They don't have to. Don't have to give you anything, and they shouldn't. That's how you teach people. You know one of the stupidest birds in the aviary--the owl. The owl. A man tested it and he had seen owls do various things that showed how stupid they were, and so he got up in a tree and took a stick and on the end of the stick he put a stuffed bird and moved it around, and when the owl came he hit the bird with...hit the owl with the stick and the owl fluttered away.
