SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes, just to be brief. I...I appreciate your indulgence in...in the abbreviated, somewhat abbreviated explanation of all this. I know there are some other questions that people have asked me, and we will put together a flow chart for you, for Select File, or before Select File, so in case you want to ask additional questions there or get things straightened out there that are not straight in your mind. We'll get you a flow chart. We'll get you the financial information of how much is flowing in and out of these different funds. And, if anybody has any additional questions on the mechanics of it, I'd certainly be glad to try to address that at any point in time. But, with that, I think you have the basic concept of the matter. And I would ask your approval to advance it to Select File. And, Senator Schrock, did you want to make any...Senator Schrock, did you want to make any final comments? Okay. Thank you, Mr. Chairman.
