SENATOR HILGERT: We can withdraw it.

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR HILGERT: I will withdraw it, withdrawn. Thank...1686, please withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: I would waive closing on this bill, other than...or I will just say this, I will commit to working now...the confusion that we had this morning, Senator Peterson, and appreciate everyone's indulgence and their patience with this process. And I ask for everyone to vote for...vote green and advance this bill to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. The question before the body is advancement of LB 176 to E & R Initial. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 176.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 176 is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 176A, Mr. President, by Senator Hilgert. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hilgert, to open on LB 176A.
