CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 2141-2142.) 33 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the passage with the emergency clause attached.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill passes with the emergency clause attached. (Visitors introduced.) While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do hereby sign LB 550 with the emergency clause attached, LB 36 with the emergency clause attached, and LB 331. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, a new A bill, LB 556A, by Senator Kristensen. (Read by title for the first time.) Senator Brashear, an amendment to LB 571 to be printed. And Natural Resources offers the committee study resolution (LR 262) allowed under the rules, Mr. President. That'll be referred to the board. Senator Schimek would like to add her name to LR 218. That's all that I have. (Legislative Journal pages 2142-2144.)
