CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Stuhr's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Smith.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 147 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 147 to E & R for engrossment. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 147A, no E & R. Senator Thompson would move to amend the bill. (AM1858. See page 2239 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Thompson, you're recognized.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor. This amendment merely expands the Cash Fund to include the extra five percent that we just amended into the previous bill. So it's just a technical amendment to allow the original five cents on the dollar that would have gone to the county treasurers now to go to the state Cash Fund that'll be used for organ and tissue donation purpose...education and awareness purposes. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: You're recognized to close, Senator Thompson. Senator Thompson waives closing. The adoption...the question is the adoption of Amendment 1858 to LB 147A. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Thompson's amendment to the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Smith.
