to prescribe controlled substances, and it changed the older-term medications to drugs and devices. Like I said, the amendment is merely technical. I don't believe there's any opposition to it. I would be glad to answer any questions, and urge the adoption of the amendment, and then the advancement of LB 828.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. We are now open for discussion on the Jensen Amendment 1893 to LB 828. Seeing no lights, Senator Jensen? Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before the body is the Jensen amendment, 1893, to LB 828. All in favor vote aye; opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? We're voting on the Jensen amendment to LB 828. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Amendment 1893 is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 828 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye; opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 571, E & R amendments first of all, Senator Smith. (AM7148. See page 2164 of the Legislative Journal.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 571.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye; opposed nay. They are adopted.
