LB 350A, 355, 382, 386

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I would move the advancement of LB 350A to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 350A to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. LB 355.

CLERK: (Read LB 355 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2316.) 49 ayes, 0 nays on the passage of LB 355, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk, LB 382E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 382 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Let's add the emergency clause. Have you voted? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2317.) The vote is 42 ayes, 6 nays, 1 present and not voting, none excused, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. LB 386.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 386 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2317-2318.) The vote is 48 ayes, 0 nays, 1 present and not voting, Mr. President.
